



STUDENT DRESS AND GROOMING

POLICY:

Student dress and grooming is the responsibility of the individual and his/her parents in cooperation with the following District guidelines:

1. Dress and grooming shall be clean and in keeping with health, sanitary and safety practices;
2. Dress and grooming shall not be such as to disrupt the teaching and learning process;
3. Students shall refrain from wearing attire which contains obscene or profane language or graphics or display articles of "clothing" that are unique to gang affiliation or promotes/advertises the use of alcohol or tobacco

A student's dress or grooming should not affect participation in school classes, programs, or other school-related activities. If the student's attire does prove to be disruptive to the educational process, the school administrator may require the student to change or modify his/her attire. Further clarification regarding expectations for student dress and grooming may be identified in student handbooks developed by each school and in the *Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook*.
