STUDENT BICYCLE, SKATEBOARD, ROLLERBLADE AND SCOOTER USE

POLICY:

Students are asked to observe safe and lawful practices when riding a bicycle, scooter, skateboard, rollerblades, or other wheeled devices to and from school property. Due to the inherent dangers to participant and non-participant, the use and storage of bicycles, scooters, skateboards, rollerblades, etc., while on school property, are subject to the rules identified in the student handbook developed by each school. Students are required to follow the expectations outlined by the school regarding the use of these vehicles as a means of transportation to and from school and the appropriate means for securing these vehicles while on school property.

Students who fail to follow the expectations outlined in this policy and the school handbook may have their vehicle confiscated by school officials for their parents to retrieve. The District assumes no responsibility or liability for loss or damage to these wheeled student possessions.

The use of these wheeled devices on school property during non-school hours is prohibited.
